Registration & Filing for Amateur Station Operators Certificate Exam (ASOC) Application

Note: Those who have already registered may go to page 13



General Guide lines:

- 1. Any citizen of India above 12 years of age can appear for the Amateur Station Operators Certificate (ASOC) Examination.
- 2. This examination is conducted by Wireless Monitoring Stations of DOT, Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India located in different parts of India, several times per year.
- 3. If more than 20 candidates are there, the examination may be held at the applicant's location.
- 4. Exam details:
- a) **Restricted Grade**: Radio Theory & Practice, Radio Regulations (1 hour exam). Qualifying Mark is 50%.
- b) **General Grade**: Radio Theory & Practice, Radio Regulations (2 hours exam), Qualifying Mark is 60% and Morse code exam at 8 words per minute.
- 5. The exam is of Multiple Choice Objective Type.
- 6. A single application can be used if the applicant wishes to appear for both the exams simultaneously.
- 7. Applicants holding degree in Engineering/Science or Diploma in Engineering and having studied Electronics or Telecommunications shall be exempted from appearing in Radio Theory & Practice part of the test. They must submit attested copy of their concerned certificate and marks memo.
- 8. Prescribed examination fees for appearing in the ASOC Exam are as under:-

SI. No.	Grade	Fee
1	Restricted	Rs.100/-
2	General	Rs.100/-
3	General & Restricted (both)	Rs.200/-

To Register in https://saralsanchar.gov.in/ first keep the following ready:

- Your PAN Card Number
 (If minor not having PAN card, No. of parent / Guardian is required)
- 2. Your cellphone ready to receive OTP sent by SMS
- 3. Your email account in logged in condition to receive OTP and messages sent by email



(Note: '*' fields are mandatory)


- Individual/ Proprietor/ Partnership Firm etc can apply for UL-VNO(CAT B)license & WPC license ONLY.
- For OSP Registration applicant need to be either Company/LLP/FCPR.
- For Access services -Category B applicant need to APPLY under UL-VNO
- For WPC Exams/Certificate Select Registration Type Category as Individual (WPC Exams/Certificates)






Fill in the required information. After filling **Authorized Contact Person** details, you will be required to fill in your **E-Mail address & Mobile Number.**

You will receive **OTPs**, both on your **E-Mail address & Mobile Number** which you entered in the earlier step.


Enter the OTPs and click on validate button to verify them.

The user credentials will be sent to the **E-Mail address** of the applicant.




Click on the **Home Button** on the above page.

Then click on **Generate OTP** button.


An OTP will be sent to your mobile phone.

Click on the APPLY NOW button on the WPC tab







Update Personal Details:

(Scanned copy as per format given in page 14 in PDF format and less than 1 MB)

g) Scanned copy of certificate of degree in Engineering with Electronics or Telecommunications or B.Sc. / M.Sc. with Electronics or Telecommunications or Diploma in Engineering with Electronics or Telecommunications certificate if any, for exemption of Part-A exam (Radio Theory & Practice) duly attested by Gazetted officer of Central or State Government (in PDF format and less than 1 MB)




2.4.1 Step 1

Applicant Details: In this step the information about applicant will appear as filled in Update personal details form above and will be able to upload documents once the form is saved using 'Save Draft'.



Once Savedraft is clicked provisional application number will be attached to your application and further actions will be taken on the same. Applicant will be able to upload the documents.





Press "next "button to go to next step.


2.4.2 Step 2

Other Details:

Next step is adding other details such as id proof and address details.

In case of Indian applicant at least one of ID proof or Nationality certificate is mandatory. Upload present and permanent address proofs.








2.4.3 Step 3

Exam Details:

Select the grade you are applying for and Exam center.



When the option shows for payment of Exam fees:

Pay Rs.100/- if you are appearing for any one grade (Restricted/General) Pay Rs.200/- if you are appearing for both grades (Restricted & General)



Note:

Once the details are added then validate application using "Validate Application" button and if validated successfully then "Submit" button will be activated. Once the application is submitted you will be redirected to dashboard and status will be as shown be redirected.





Upon scrutiny of documents, photograph, payment etc. by WPC/WMO/DoT, necessary instructions on correction & re-uploading of documents etc. if any, would be conveyed to the applicant through email / SMS alerts. This can also be monitored / downloaded by applicants on SARAL Sanchar **Dashboard** of the applicant's login.

If scrutiny is not successful then applicant has to modify and resubmit it. Applicant may **communicate** with respective WPC Nodal through portal and may also submit additional/required documents, if any. Applicant may also raise a **Helpdesk** request through portal.

Once the application is scrutinized successfully the applicant will be notified of the exam date and venue through SMS once it is decided by Wireless Monitoring Station. The **Admit Card** can be **downloaded** from portal by logging into www.saralsanchar.gov.in and following the details given below:

- 6) Download Admit Card



The printout of the Admit Card must be taken with you when you appear for the exam along with id proof and original of other documents which were submitted on line.



INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

- Print this Admit Card on an A4 size paper. Admit Card is valid only if the candidate's photograph image is legibly printed.
- 2. The Admit Card is to be produced for verification at the time of the test. At least one original(not photocopied or scanned) valid (not expired) Photo identification card (such as Driving Licence, Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID, Aadhaar Card) should also be presented. The photo ID card should not be damaged or smudged.
- 3. Date of Birth Proof, Address proof, Proof for Exemption in Part A and Undertaking certificate (For students between ages 12 and 18) may be produced to the examiner for verification.
- 4. Mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets such as calculators, watches are NOT ALLOWED inside the test centre.
- 5. Candidates should report at the test venue 30 minutes prior to the start of the test. No candidate will be permitted afterthe commencement of the test.
- 6. The Admit Card is provisional subject to the condition that the candidate has fulfilled the eligibility conditions like age, academic qualification (in case of exemption from Part A) etc. as mentioned in the application.
- 7. This Admit card is valid only for the test date and time as specified above.
